

QUALIFICATIONS FOR GOLD PIN AWARDS

The Gold Pin Awards, instituted in January, 1968, revised in 2010, will be presented to EGSPC members/owners whose dogs have fulfilled the following requirements:

1. To be eligible for a Gold Pin an EGSPC member's dog must have earned an AKC recognized title.
2. If a dog is co-owned with one or more persons, ONE owner of record must be an EGSPC member in good standing at the time the title was earned and at the time of presentation.
3. The EGSPC will provide only one (1) pin per title, regardless of the number of owner/co-owners. Additional titles earned by the same dog will also be recognized.
4. It is the responsibility of the **member/owner** to notify the Gold Pin Awards Chairperson of any AKC titles earned by his/her dogs by the completion of this form. Please attach copy of the AKC certificate as proof of title. Also provide copy of dog's current registration if changed during the time title was earned.
5. The following criteria must apply:
 - A. Show Championship: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog earned a minimum of nine (9) points toward the Championship, including both qualifying majors.
Grand Championship: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog earned a minimum of sixteen (16) points towards the grand championship, including all three qualifying majors.
 - B. Field Title: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog earned a minimum of six (6) points toward the Championship including the qualifying majors.
 - C. Hunt Titles: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog has earned a minimum of seventy-five percent (75%) of the qualifying legs.
 - D. Obedience, Rally and Agility Titles: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog has earned two of the three (2 of 3) legs.
 - i. titles requiring ten legs owner must have been member during the time the dog earned (7) seven of the required (10) ten legs.
 - ii. titles requiring (100) legs, owner must have been member of the EGSPC during the time the dog earned (70) seventy of the (100) one hundred legs.
 - E. Obedience Trial Championship: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog has earned a minimum of sixty (60) of the required one hundred (100) points toward the Championship as well as two (2) of the three (3) required first (1st) placings.
 - F. Master Agility Championship: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog has earned a minimum of (500) five hundred of the required (750) seven hundred fifty points as well as the (15) fifteen of the required (20) twenty double qualifiers.
 - G. Tracking Titles: The owner must have owned the dog and been EGSPC member during the time the dog has qualified for the Test Certification.
Champion Tracker title dog and handler (owner and member of EGSPC) must complete the TD(Tracking Dog), TDX(Tracking Dog Excellent) and VST(Variable Surface Tracking) titles. Owner must have owned dog and been member of EGSPC during the time (2) two of the (3) tracking titles were earned.

Gold Pin Awards will be announced, and the pins presented at the general membership meeting in February of the following year.

EASTERN GERMAN SHORTHAIRED POINTER CLUB
OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS CRITERIA

1. The accomplishment to be that of the dog, not the owner, handler or trainer.
2. The owner must be a member of the EGSPC and have been a member at the time of the accomplishment.
3. The dog must be a German Shorthaired Pointer.
4. Only living dogs are recognized unless the achievement has a continuing quality about it-e.g. - All Time Producing Sire, Dam or the achievement is the election to the GSP Hall of Fame.
5. The achievement must be truly unique. Some achievements to be considered are: Dual Champion, National Champion, Best In Show, Obedience Trial Champion, Top Sire or Dam of the Year, Top Gun Dog/Show Dog of the Year, Regional and State Champions, Futurity Winners, Completing all Hunt Test Titles in one year.
6. Decisions of the committee are final.

****Deadline: All nominations must be received by February 5^h (Awards announced at the Annual Meeting in February and presented at a later date).**

The committee welcomes the nominations from anyone for consideration of recognition. First time recipients receive an award and framed certificate, repeaters receive a framed certificate.
